

## DHF TAKES OWNERSHIP OF NEW BUILDING

On December 31, DHF completed the closing process for the Lovington Masonic lodge building.

The building is a 20-year-old steel and brick building with 4,500 square feet of interior space. The Masonic group merged with a lodge in a nearby town, and sold the building to DHF for a fraction of its value.

It will be several months before the DHF offices can be moved. Some roof repairs are needed, but have to wait for warmer weather. In the meantime, quite a bit of the remodeling can be done. No drywall can be hung until the roof is fixed, but removing some walls and framing in the new ones can be done by volunteers.
