

## Lynn Cazier survives carjacking

In November, Lynn Cazier was the victim of a carjacking. Lynn was driving in Nairobi near his home when three armed thieves forced Lynn to stop the car and get in the back, then demanded money and his cell phone. The thieves did not know how to drive the car, and began going in reverse. Lynn was able to open the car door, roll out on the ground while the car was moving and escape before the carjackers could get control of the car.

The car was recovered a short distance away, but the engine was ruined. Lynn had a heel injury and some cuts and scrapes, but otherwise was unharmed.
